## Inflectional Ending *-ed*

### Focus

- Adding **-ed** to a verb creates the past tense of the verb.  
They **work** from dawn to dusk. They **worked** from dawn to dusk.
- Verbs that end with **-ed** can also be used as adjectives or participles.  
That **baked** apple smells great!
