## Prepositional Phrases

### Focus

A **preposition** relates a noun or pronoun to the rest of the sentence.

- He visited the house **near** the river.

A **prepositional phrase** is a group of words that begins with a preposition and ends with the *object* of the preposition.

- on the *farm*

### Practice
